

Comp2403 Robotics Progression Week Activity

Motivation

This activity is designed to give you some experience in preparing for your assignment. This involves voice-recording your explanations to 4 questions I shall ask you, based on your portfolio of work. **This is entirely optional.**

What to do.

- 1) You will need to team up with another member of your class
- 2) You will both choose one activity (worksheet)
- 3) You will individually voice-record answers to the two questions below on the activity
- 4) You will share your voice-recordings with each other, and grade each other's recording according to the guidance below
- 5) You will return your grading to your partner.
- 6) Both will send the voice recordings and gradings to me, and I shall send you both my grading.

Questions

For your chosen activity, answer these two questions.

- A) Explain (in general terms) what the activity was trying to achieve.
- B) Explain (in as much detail as you can) the algorithm, or approach AND the code used

Guidance for Grading.

Look for explanations rather than descriptions.

Rate the number of good explanation sentence(s).

Rate the quality of each explanation sentence(s)

Rate how the explanations fit together as a whole, to make the entire recording coherent.

Grade C (adequate)	Several reasonable explanation sentence(s) or one or two good explanation sentences
Grade B (good)	Many good explanation sentences
Grade A (excellent)	Many good explanation sentences, with clear evidence of the explanations building up an impression of coherence

This, as in most grading is somewhat subjective. But, by now, you have a feel of what a good piece of work looks like.

Don't worry too much about getting the grade right. The whole point of this activity is to get some experience of voice-recording answers to questions, and seeing how other people approach this.
